A. SPECIAL INFORMATION

ATLANTO-AXIAL INSTABILITY

At this particular event the depth of the pool is deep enough to dive therefore, we will be **“allowing”** off the board diving at this event. (As you are aware this is a problem, which Down syndrome athletes may have. There are quite a few sports that can cause pressure on the neck and if the athlete has this instability it can have serious effects. Therefore we request that all swimmers participating have a neck X-ray, and a note from an authorized doctor.)

Swimmers are at higher risk if they swim the butterfly, dive or do a racing start into the water. We must in this case insist that all swimmers with no medical form or letter from their doctor will NOT BE ALLOWED to enter the butterfly events. They will also have to start in the water for all other events.

◆ SIGHT SEEING

Teams will be informed at the Head of Delegation meeting about the arrangements for the day in Taipei for a city tour. Followed by a tour of Taipei 101, the world's tallest skyscraper.

◆ POOL

25m Indoor Pool will be used for competition. 10 lanes will be used

◆ ENTRIES

All ages are invited to participate.

All races are open, no age groups.

Please make sure that accurate “entries times” are submitted for each event

On the official entry form. See qualifying times in appendix 1

Entry limitations teams can enter a maximum of 3 swimmers in each event

(and 800m Freestyle (Women); 1500m Freestyle (Men) and 2k Open Water)

◆ EVENTS

All the events will be run on a time banding system.

The individual races being of one length (25m), two lengths (50m), four lengths

(100m), Eight lengths (200m), sixteen lengths (400m)

Open Events of 800m, 1500m and 2K open water

◆ SWIMMING TECHNIQUE

Would team managers please ensure that all competitors entered in this event have recognized stroke movements as defined in the DSISO Handbook. To avoid disappointment of disqualification, a swimmer with a suspect left or arm actions should be entered into the freestyle events. If you are in any doubt contact your local swimming instructor.

◆ CLOSING DATE

First closing date will be **31 DECEMBER 2006** for teams to show their interest in bringing a team. Final closing date for entries will be **15 MAY 2007**

◆ POOLSIDE HELPERS

Each team is allowed **TWO** persons at poolside while the swimmers are waiting for their races. Once the competitor has been handed over to the final race Marshalls no contact is allowed. You may then collect the competitor after the presentation of their medals. All the helpers who are going to be at the poolside must wear soft shoes e.g. trainers at poolside shoes.

◆ PROGRAMMES

All teams will be provided with programs at the Head of Delegation meeting. Extra programs will be available.

◆ AWARDS

Awards will be presented after each stroke or as announced at the team managers meeting. Swimmers will be awarded after each band. Details will be announced at the team managers meeting. Swimmers will be awarded after each band. Details will be announced at the team managers meeting. If swimmer should get a disqualified he/she will not be rewarded. The decision of the referees is final. The fastest overall male and female swimmer from each event e.g. 25m Freestyle, will receive a trophy at the Closing Ceremony.
